



Q: What is the difference between Allergy Friendly Meals and Allergen & Nutrition Reports?

A: Revolution Foods provides a monthly Allergen & Nutrition Report concerning the ingredients used in meals.

Monthly Allergen & Nutrition Reports (“allergen reports”) are provided and made available for all meals served by Revolution Foods. These allergen reports are based on information as stated and disclosed in the manufacturer’s product specifications sheet for each product. Revolution Foods does NOT test these meals nor the products contained therein for *any* allergens. Revolution Foods relies on the information provided by manufacturers and vendors as to the ingredients of each meal or meal component and conveys such to our customers. As the ingredients in each meal may change from time to time, please note that the allergen reports will also change. Each customer is responsible for reviewing the allergen report(s) in addition to any meal packaging labels prior to serving meals not labeled as *Allergy Friendly Meals* as Revolution Foods is unable to confirm whether such meals are free from allergens and disclaim any such allegation asserting liability.

On occasion, Revolution Foods may *without notice* substitute meal components. Such substitutions will consist of items already listed on that month’s menu and monthly allergen report. As a reminder, where the meals are not labeled as *Allergy Friendly Meals*, Revolution Foods is unable to test, confirm and guarantee the meals are free from allergens.

Revolution Foods only tests Allergy Friendly Meals for the Top 9 Allergens.

Revolution Foods offers and provides *Allergy Friendly Meals* that are free from the Food and Drug Administration’s designated “Top 9 Allergens” as of the date of this letter. The Top 9 Allergens include (1) dairy, (2) egg, (3) fish, (4) peanut, (5) sesame, (6) shellfish, (7) soy, (8) tree nut, and (9) wheat. Revolution Foods’ *Allergy Friendly Meals* are lab-tested to verify the absence of the Top 9 Allergens.

Q: Is Revolution Foods a peanut-free facility?

A: Revolution Foods does not claim to be a peanut-free facility. Revolution Foods does not claim nor do we guarantee our vendors and manufacturers operate out of peanut-free facilities.

While it is Revolution Foods’ practice to not procure food containing peanuts, Revolution Foods does not claim to be a peanut-free facility. Additionally, please be advised that Revolution Foods’ vendors and manufacturers are not required to operate out of peanut-free facilities.

Customers are not relieved of any liability concerning the meals it serves.

Customers are offered *Allergy Friendly Meals* and provided allergen reports to be informed of the ingredients used in Revolution Foods’ provided meals. Revolution Foods disclaims any liability regarding an allergic reaction to meals after such meals and reports are delivered. Customers are responsible and remain solely liable in ensuring those with life-threatening allergies are not exposed to ingredients that would cause an adverse allergic reaction. Customers are explicitly advised to order and serve meals from Revolution Foods’ *Allergy Friendly Menu* to those with a life-threatening allergy to any of the Top 9 Allergens to prevent any adverse reactions.
